Tararua District Council Submission to Horizons Regional Council 22 April 2024

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on your draft Long Term Plan.

We have submitted on additional items we wish to draw your attention to first (items 1) and then we provide feedback on the matters you have identified as key subject areas in your plans (items 2).

1 Tararua District Council Additional Items

1.1 Slow-down Compliance

The change of policy direction indicated from the new National-led Government is likely to significantly reduce compliance requirements and simplify processes.

We understand therefore that there is great uncertainty for regional local government regarding the nature, extent and timing of these changes. Consequently, the draft Long-Term Plan and its resourcing within must assume for the moment, the continuance for compliance and regional council responsibility for enforcement based on current legislation and regulation.

However, given the clear direction, and in our experience, impact that a similar change in policy direction has had on three waters, we recommend that you reduce, wherever possible, the speed at which you seek to comply with the previous Government's policy setting and defer to wait and prepare to submit on amending or new legislation and regulation.

The financial impacts of change may provide significant savings against those being planned for in this Long-Term Plan.

Recommendation

We recommend that Council delay implementing the previous Government's policy position where they have been signalled for change by the new Government.

Furthermore, that savings achieved by the delay or modification of policy be transparently used to help offset following years rate impost, either through processes of the 2025/26 Annual Plan or if required, amended Long-Term Plan.

1.2 Continue to Invest in Telemetry for Climate Change and Emergency Events

Cyclone Gabrielle highlighted the need for broader regional data from Telemetry systems. This information was critical during the declaration and monitoring process of the Emergency event. Additional rollout of monitoring stations is now taking place. However, we would like to see continued investment and expansion of monitoring systems over

multiple metrics such as temperature, humidity, rainfall, river data and ground water. In particular, Tararua District Council seeks to increase our own resilience for Dannevirke Water and Woodville Water sources. Ground mapping. In this respect, environmental measurement of water sources for Dannevirke on Laws Road and those potentially for Woodville would be a significant assistance to us as a council.

Recommendation

That funding be provided for additional telemetry stations in the Tararua and Region be made over the coming years, with priority given in 2024/25 for additional monitoring of the Tamaki River at Laws Road, outside of Dannevirke.

1.3 Develop Further Flood Plain Modelling

Climate change is impacting on our towns and region. Flood plain hazard mapping is a critical way to assess vulnerability. Horizons Regional Council has already assessed flood plain modelling for Pahiatua and Woodville. However, we would like to ask if Council could please extend this work to Dannevirke and Eketahuna, for which both locations have had recent updated LiDAR assessments completed and shared by us.

Recommendation

That funding be provided for flood plain modelling for Dannevirke and Eketahuna Towns and catchment areas.

2 Horizons Specific Matter for Consultation

2.1 Te Anga Rautaki Strategic Framework

We agree with the strategic framework that outlines Council's vision, Tō tātou rohe – taiao ora, tangata ora, mauri ora. Our place – a healthy environment where people are thriving; with:

Four strategic priorities of:

- Freshwater • Climate Change • Unlocking Information, and • Biodiversity

And outcomes of:

- ecosystems are healthy
- has effective transport networks
- communities are resilient to the impacts of natural hazards and climate change
- economy is thriving
- communities are vibrant and empowered

These are consistent with the Tararua District's Strategy.

Issue 1: Modify Level of service for highly productive land

In line with item 1 above, changes have been signalled by the Government to the National Policy Statement for Highly Productive Land 2022, e.g., classifications, other functionality and requirements may change. This may mean that Horizons Regional Council may need to modify the approach for the requirement to map land as highly productive as general rural or rural production zone and is predominately classified as Land Use Capability (LUC) 1, 2 or 3 land.

Option 2 with targeted mapping focussing on areas in every district where there is urban growth pressure and/or demand for rural lifestyle subdivision would seem most appropriate of the options.

Recommendation

That Council continue with project planning for an option 2 approach for its compliance, and if possible, wait for further Government direction before proceeding.

2.2 Issue 2: Planning for the Future

We agree with Option 1 being Council's preferred option, to fund work programme for integrated catchment management.

We agree that it is important to understand in a more holistic manner river management and drainage schemes and their wider ecosystems, water, land, plant and animal life, and affected communities.

However, we note the Federated Farmers do not support this option and we would like further opportunities to discuss this together as working alongside our farmers achieves maximum results for our District.

Recommendation

That Council fund the work programme for integrated catchment management.

2.3 Issue 3a: Updates to operational areas – increase river management insurances

Shifting risk at present is still financially viable for councils. However, increasing climate risk may mean more self-insurance may be required in the future. With greater exposure to more extreme events, insurance remains a critical way of spreading risk. The cost of premium and policy cover needs to be monitored on regular basis and potentially varied to balance risk with cost.

Recommendation

That Option 1 be selected – To include baseline inflation, revaluations, claim up to \$200 million per event by Horizons and up to \$500 million alongside other councils.

2.4 Issue 3b: Updates to operational areas –levels of service for freshwater activity

This work has had a positive environmental outcome for many farms. However, the agricultural sector is suffering inflated cost and lowering commodity price returns. A gradual cost change is suggested, should Council proceed.

With the loss of Government funding input and funding for fencing, maintaining close to the current level of tree planting is preferred. However, this could be phased to the higher level (option three) over the first three years.

Recommendation

That Council consider option 1 is adequate at this time.

2.5 Issue 3c: Public Transport

2.5.1 Whanganui improvements

2.5.2 New services for Horowhenua

2.5.3 New and improved regional services (including the Tararua District)

We note the comments made by Tararua Federated Farmers. Transport costs support the local communities stay connected and local economic wellbeing. We concur that the farming community are likely to have a lower benefit to accessing these services, and so rating should reflect the cost to the level of public good that accrues by having these services to the wider community.

With the development of electric vehicles, the cost of this form of transport is likely to reduce over time. We would suggest a phase-in approach to confirm the level of demand and better assess and set the future level of service.

Of special note, the Saint John Ambulance funding is seen as a critical service to the District and we strongly wish for this funding to continue.

Recommendation

That transport rates align charges to the communities that benefit.

That option two (lower cost) be introduced so that this can be reviewed in future years.

That St John funding continue at the current rate.
