#### Tararua District Council Submission to Horizons Regional Council 22 April 2024

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on your draft Long Term Plan.

We have submitted on additional items we wish to draw your attention to first (items 1) and then we provide feedback on the matters you have identified as key subject areas in your plans (items 2).

#### 1 Tararua District Council Additional Items

## 1.1 Slow-down Compliance

The change of policy direction indicated from the new National-led Government is likely to significantly reduce compliance requirements and simplify processes.

We understand therefore that there is great uncertainty for regional local government regarding the nature, extent and timing of these changes. Consequently, the draft Long-Term Plan and its resourcing within must assume for the moment, the continuance for compliance and regional council responsibility for enforcement based on current legislation and regulation.

However, given the clear direction, and in our experience, impact that a similar change in policy direction has had on three waters, we recommend that you reduce, wherever possible, the speed at which you seek to comply with the previous Government's policy setting and defer to wait and prepare to submit on amending or new legislation and regulation.

The financial impacts of change may provide significant savings against those being planned for in this Long-Term Plan.

### Recommendation

We recommend that Council delay implementing the previous Government's policy position where they have been signalled for change by the new Government.

Furthermore, that savings achieved by the delay or modification of policy be transparently used to help offset following years rate impost, either through processes of the 2025/26 Annual Plan or if required, amended Long-Term Plan.

### 1.2 Continue to Invest in Telemetry for Climate Change and Emergency Events

Cyclone Gabrielle highlighted the need for broader regional data from Telemetry systems. This information was critical during the declaration and monitoring process of the Emergency event. Additional rollout of monitoring stations is now taking place. However, we would like to see continued investment and expansion of monitoring systems over

multiple metrics such as temperature, humidity, rainfall, river data and ground water. In particular, Tararua District Council seeks to increase our own resilience for Dannevirke Water and Woodville Water sources. Ground mapping. In this respect, environmental measurement of water sources for Dannevirke on Laws Road and those potentially for Woodville would be a significant assistance to us as a council.

#### Recommendation

That funding be provided for additional telemetry stations in the Tararua and Region be made over the coming years, with priority given in 2024/25 for additional monitoring of the Tamaki River at Laws Road, outside of Dannevirke.

# 1.3 Develop Further Flood Plain Modelling

Climate change is impacting on our towns and region. Flood plain hazard mapping is a critical way to assess vulnerability. Horizons Regional Council has already assessed flood plain modelling for Pahiatua and Woodville. However, we would like to ask if Council could please extend this work to Dannevirke and Eketahuna, for which both locations have had recent updated LiDAR assessments completed and shared by us.

#### Recommendation

That funding be provided for flood plain modelling for Dannevirke and Eketahuna Towns and catchment areas.
